Meetings

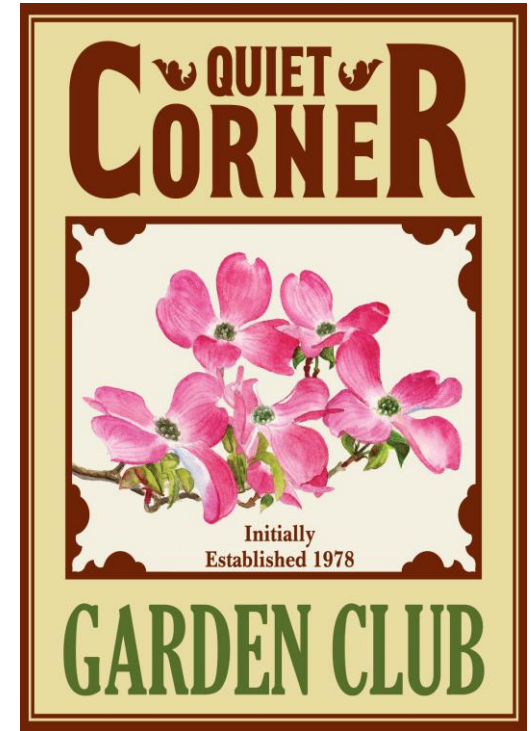
Place: S. Baptist Church Meeting Hall
